

Rules for using the group study rooms in the University Library

By entering the group study rooms, you agree to the following rules of use.

If a breach of the rules is detected, the right of use may be withdrawn. In addition, compensation may have to be paid.

Room utilisation

1. If the booked group study room is not occupied by the group within 15 minutes of the start of the reserved booking period, the reservation will be cancelled.
2. At least two group members must be present in the booked group study room at all times, otherwise the reservation will be cancelled.
3. The maximum group size of 6 people must not be exceeded.
4. The display of items (e.g. bags, clothing, work materials) is not considered a reservation and is expressly prohibited.
5. Individuals must vacate the group study rooms for groups of two or more people
6. The group room 01.1.008 is designed as a parent-child room and must be vacated immediately for users with children despite a reservation.

Cleanliness and order

7. It is not permitted to bring hot food or alcoholic beverages.
8. Loud conversations and noise are to be avoided.
9. The rooms are to be left in a tidy condition. The materials provided remain in the group study rooms and may not be taken away.

University Library staff are authorised to monitor and enforce compliance with the rules at all times. On instruction, the group study rooms must be vacated immediately.
